

# ASCENSION HAT

-A YARNLEY LANE PATTERN -



The Ascension Hat combines sturdy stockinette with a simple garter stitch design that ascends to the top of the hat. Knit in a bright, bulky yarn, this hat can quickly rise to the challenge, just like you!

## **Materials:**

Yarn: 1 Skein Quince & Co. Puffin (shown in Peak's Ferry)

Needles: circular needles, sizes 9 and 10

Other: tapestry needle, pompom maker (optional)

## **Abbreviations:**

CO - Cast on

C2L - Slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in front, K1, K1 from cable needle

C2R- Slip 1 stitch to cable needle and hold in back, K1, K1 from cable needle

K- Knit

KFB- Knit front back

K2tog- Knit two together

P- Purl

## **Pattern:**

CO 64 stitches on smaller needles ( I like the [Rib Cable Cast On](#)). Join in the round, placing marker for beginning of the round.

K1 P1 for 1.5 inches

Switch to larger needles

P 1 round

[K 7, KFB] Rep to end (72 Stitches)

**Work in Ascension Pattern, Knitting all even numbered rows:**

Row 1: K 1, P34, K to end

Row 3: C2L P32, C2R, K to end

Row 5:K1, C2L, P30, C2R, K to end

Row 7: K2, C2L, P28, C2R, K to end

Row 9: K3, C2L, P26, C2R, K to end

Row 11: K4, C2L, P24, C2R, K to end

Row 13: K5, C2L, P22, C2R, K to end

Row 15: K6, C2L, P20, C2R, K to end

Row 17: K7, C2L, P18, C2R, K to end

Row 19: K8, C2L, P16, C2R, K to end

Row 21: K9, C2L, P16, C2R, K to end

Row 23: K10, C2L, P14, C2R, K to end

Row 25: K11, C2L, P12, C2R, K to end

Row 27: K12, C2L, P10, C2R, K to end

Row 29: K13, C2L, P12, C2R, K to end



Row 31: K14, C2L, P10, C2R, K to end

Row 33: K15, C2L, P8, C2R, K to end

Row 35: K16, C2L, P6, C2R, K to end

Row 37: K17, C2L, P4, C2R, K to end

Row 39: K18, C2L, P2, C2R, K to end

Row 41: K19, C2L, C2R, K to end
